## RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Must have Solar Installation experience with various Roof Mounted systems, ground mounts, commercial and residential.**
- Show up on time (or early), ready to work with proper, presentable attire and shoes
- Think ahead, review available information, ask questions and prepare prior to deploying to a job
- Mobilize crew to be on the road by 8:15AM each day
- Keep accurate records for each project, including as built drawings and materials used
- Emailing 2:30PM project progress updates each day
- Interface with the homeowner or client representative respectfully
- Delegate responsibilities and manage your crew for optimal results
- Consistently and accurately keep records of work hours and tasks
- Be thoroughly familiar with the location and usage of tools, equipment and materials on service vehicle and in shop
- Communicate to procurement as early as possible when items need to be ordered for a job or restocked
- Have personal, basic, electrical hand tools, including: linesman pliers, wire strippers, screw and nut drivers, Allen wrenches, channel wrench, etc.
- Safely operate tools and equipment without unnecessary wear and tear or damage, and report any damage to management immediately
- Return tools, equipment and materials to their proper location after use
- Ensure that jobsite conduct is appropriate and respectful to the Client, their property and fellow employees – stay positive
- Observe safe work practices and report any unsafe conditions, tools or activities to Construction Manager
